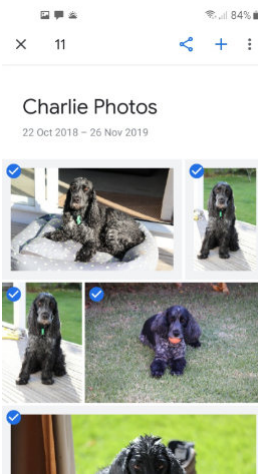
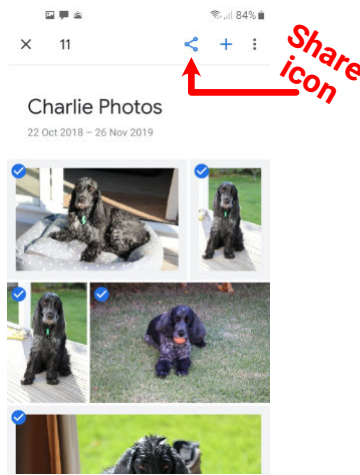


Microsoft OneDrive is an online storage service. A limited, free version of OneDrive is available to anyone, and a full version with 1 TB of storage is included with Microsoft Office 365 or as a separate purchase. A fantastic use of OneDrive is sharing your photos between your devices. This means you can say goodbye to your USB cables for downloading photos from your phone.

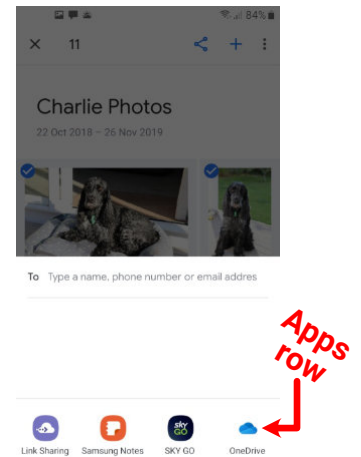

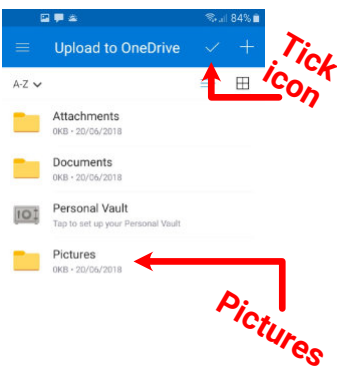
Open your Photos app and select the photos you want send to OneDrive.



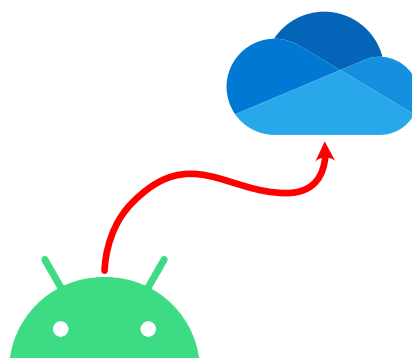
Touch on the share icon in the top, right of the screen.



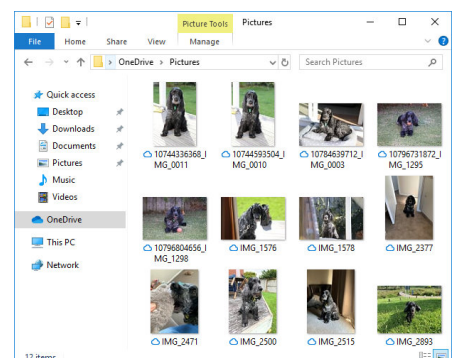
Touch on OneDrive on the Apps row. You may need to scroll to the end of the row to find it.



To upload your photos to the Pictures folder, touch on Pictures. Then, touch on the tick icon at the top.



Your photos will upload to OneDrive in the background. You can continue to use your phone while this happens.



Your photos will be available on your other devices once they have synced with your OneDrive in the cloud.
