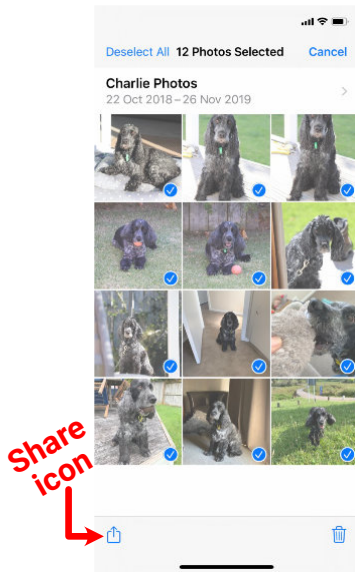
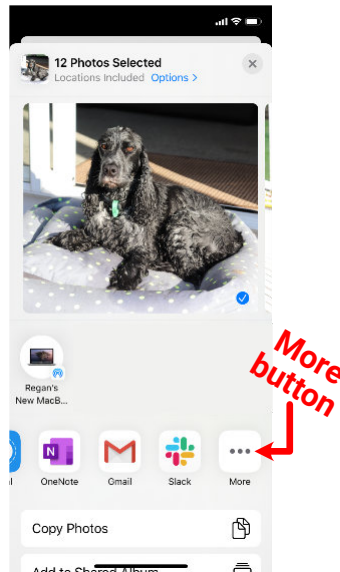


Microsoft OneDrive is an online storage service. A limited, free version of OneDrive is available to anyone, and a full version with 1 TB of storage is included with Microsoft Office 365 or as a separate purchase. A fantastic use of OneDrive is sharing your photos between your devices. This means you can say goodbye to your USB cables for downloading photos from your phone.

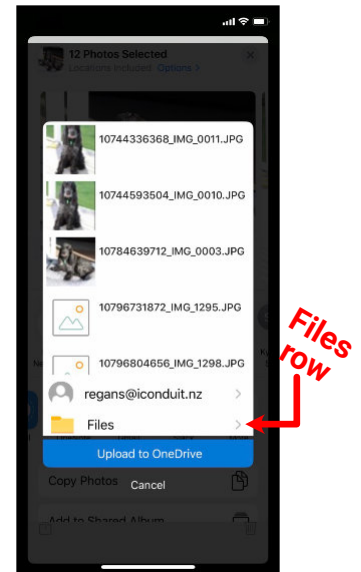

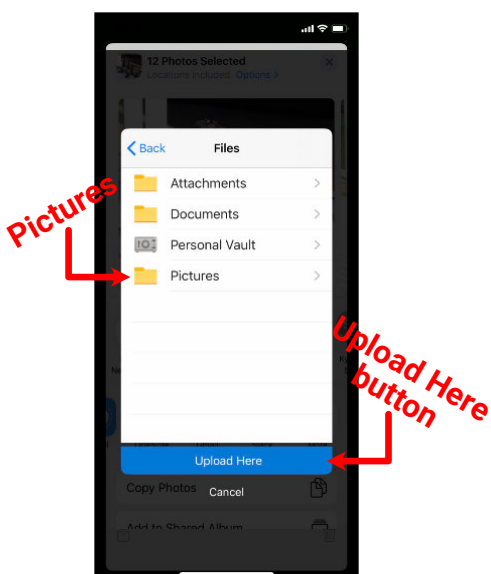
Open your Photos app and select the photos you want share to OneDrive. Then, touch on the share icon in the bottom, left of the screen.



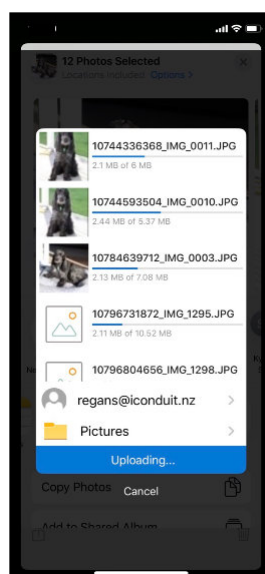
Touch on More in the Apps row. You may need to scroll to the end of the row to find it. Choose OneDrive from the list of apps.



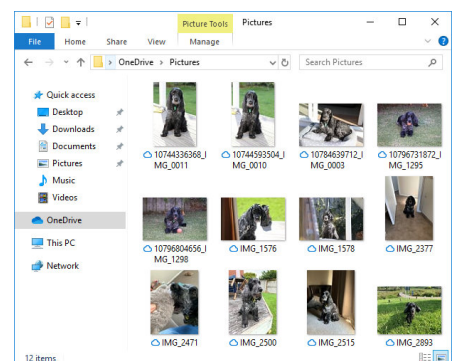
To select where to upload your photos, touch on Files.



Touch on Pictures or navigate to where you want to save your photos. The list will change to show the contents of the selected folder. Next, click the Upload Here button.



Your photos will upload to OneDrive. Once uploading is complete, you'll be returned to the Photos app.



Your photos will be available on your other devices once they have synced with your OneDrive in the cloud.
